



  - d) Estate making a **TOTAL of 829 dwelling.**








# Traveller and Gypsy site Policy GT1

#### 5. Traveller and Gypsy site - Policy GT1

- a) All Government required provision of Traveller and Gypsy site allocation in this small corner of Rayleigh.
- b) Planning Inspector has asked if the allocation could be 'swapped' with part of the site NEL1, South of London Road if delivery is not possible on site NEL2.
- c) This site will be likely to end up South of London Road without protest. Using all our local facilities without paying one penny towards them







## How does 15 pitches = 30 caravans?






#### Minimum of 30 Families

#### Example of a 12 Pitch Site


#### **Designing Gypsy and Traveller Sites**

7.12 Nevertheless, as a general guide, it is possible to specify that an average family pitch must be capable of accommodating an amenity building, a large trailer and touring caravan, (or two trailers, drying space for clothes, a lockable shed (for bicycles, wheelchair storage etc), parking space for two vehicles and a small garden area.

"About 20 families, many with children, have been living in squalid conditions, with no running water or mains electricity, since the high-profile, £7m eviction in October 2011."




